Dear parents and guardians:

This summer, Summit High School will be offering summer school to help our students get on track and stay on track for graduation. Below you will find information regarding our summer school:

There are two summer school sessions for the 2017 year at Summit High: **Session 1 [Monday, June 5 – Friday, June 23]** and **Session 2 [Monday, June 26 – Tuesday, July 18] (closed July 3rd and 4th)**. We will offer five classes per day, and students can earn .625 credit by passing their classes Monday – Thursday (.125 credits per class) for each session (a total of 1.25 credits if they attend both sessions). Students may enroll in one session or both sessions.

Summit will also offer activities each Friday as an opportunity to earn additional credit. If a student attends each Friday activity, they will earn .125 credit per session (.25 total). **These Friday activities are optional.**

Additional credit is available through our credit recovery programs (Lifelong Readers, Arts Independent Study, Doug's Dead Poet Society, etc.).

Since there are only 12 days of summer school each session, attendance is critical. If a student misses more than 3 days they will be dropped from summer school. If you plan to take a family vacation or have other obligations that involve your student missing more than 3 days of summer school we suggest you contact us and let us help you enroll your student in one of the following options for summer school in Alpine School District:

- East Shore Online
- Mountain View High School (Extended Year Program)
- Lehi High School (Extended Year Program)

Students who are in custody of the State must have a clearance letter to attend these schools. East Shore, Mountain View, and Lehi have all generously agreed to waive fees for these students.

Other information about Summit High School's summer school:

- All fees are waived for summer school, including for students not in state custody
- Transportation is NOT provided for summer school.
- No breakfast or lunch provided.
- School is held 8:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Monday – Thursday. Friday's schedule will vary slightly depending on the activity, but we will try to stick to our regular schedule as much as possible.

Registration for summer school begins on *May 1, 2017*. **The final day of registration for summer school is June 2.** Please call 801-610-8183 to schedule an appointment. We hope to be able to enroll all interested students. However, if enrollment fills up, priority will be given to Juniors and Seniors.
